• The University of Medicine and Pharmacy "Carol Davila" Bucharest is partner in several EU Horizon2020 projects that have the central focus on telemedicine and eHealth solutions.

Eg:



- vCare project aims to provide a smart coaching solution grounded on personalized care pathways. vCare stands for Virtual Coaching activities for rehabilitation in elderly and aims at an improved rehabilitation for people as they age. vCare is designing personalised rehabilitation programmes that will lead to better continuity of care and a better quality of life for patients who use an advanced virtual coaching system. The clinical use cases of the Romanian partener focus on heart failure, ischaemic heart disease. https://vcare-project.eu/
- **PROCare4Life** project is proposing an integrated scalable and interactive care ecosystem, easily adapted to several chronic diseases, care institutions and end-user needs, benefiting individuals, families and health professionals. https://procare4life.eu/
- InteropEHRate will develop open interchange protocols supporting patient-centred exchange of health records between patients, healthcare actors and researchers. Thus, the project will contribute to the next steps in the follow-up of the February 2019 EC recommendation and help to pave the way towards an open European EHR exchange format and process. It will specifically add a decentral, patient-driven bottom-up approach as an alternative method to the top-down approach of exchanging patient data exclusively via the national contact for points for eHealth (NCPeH).
