- Facilitating cooperation between local authorities and the interested parties at the regional level, but also the collaboration between regional ecosystems at EU level.












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Overall Concept

- The engagement and discussion will kick-start on the basis of <u>SAPHIRe</u>- a Consortium for Securing the Adoption of Personalised Health in Regions.







What is Integrated Community Care (ICC)?

ICC is an emerging concept to health and well-being that is determined by the needs and preferences of individuals and the communities in which they live.

- A paradigm shift in the way health and care systems are organized: from 'delivery' to 'co-development'.
- Focus on both quality of care and quality of life.
- Communities are essential partners: relationships, expertise, contextual knowledge, entrepreneurship and locally supportive and responsive ecosystems.
- Addresses the broader determinants of health through evidence-informed policies and actions across all sectors.




What ICC entails?

- Greater integration between primary care, public health functions, social work and neighbourhood development within a given territory.
- A continuous process of 'whole system innovation'. Distributed power and collective learning are the cornerstones.
- Relationship-based and place-based. It seeks to care for people living in the home environment and focuses on the promotion of health and wellbeing as well as tackling key issues such as social exclusion and social isolation.
- Accountability towards a territorially defined population, which provides the rationale behind the link with and involvement of local authorities.
- ❖ ICC's 'raîson d'etre' goes way beyond 'care'. It is just as much about activating and reinforcing the social ties between people.



How TransForm fosters bottom-up appropries to ICE (1)



- Different stakeholders join forces to make ICC a reality: the user/citizens, the professional, the community, and the policymaker.
- Stakeholders are connected through a range of strategies to support continuous processes of co-developing health, care and social support infrastructures and services.
- TransForm established seven effectiveness principles as clear statements that provide guidance to foster change to ICC.



VALUE

and foster the capacities of all actors. including citizens, in the community to become change agents and to coproduce health and wellbeing. This requires the active involvement of all actors, with an extra sensitivity to the most vulnerable ones.

FOSTER

the creation of local alliances among all actors which are involved in the production of health and wellbeing in the community, Develop a shared vision and common goals. Actively strive for balanced power relations and mutual trust within these alliances

STRENGTHEN

community-oriented primary care that stimulates people's capabilities to maintain health and/or to live in the community with complex chronic conditions. Take people's life goals as the starting point to define the desired outcomes of care and support.

IMPROVE

public health and reduce health disparities by addressing the social, economic and environmental determinants of health in the community and investing in prevention and health promotion. social infrastructure.

SUPPORT

healthy and inclusive communities by providing to bring people together and by investing in both social care and

DEVELOP

the legal continuously the quality of and financial conditions to enable the coand support at community


EVALUATE

care and support and the status of health and wellbeing in the community by using methods and indicators which are grounded within the foregoing principles. Provide opportunities for joint learning Adapt policies, services and activities in accordance with the evaluation outcomes.

TransForm, the Transnational Forum on Integrated Community Care, is a joint initiative of Foundations in Europe and Canada that aims to put the community at the centre of primary and integrated care.



The Changemakers Forum

- Drive progress and innovation in the field of ICC at the national and international levels.
- Foster bottom-up approaches where communities develop their own models of caring for their people.
- Generate change at policy and practice level by engaging policymakers, practitioners and key stakeholders.
